# WHAT'S FISCAL SPONSORSHIP?

Fiscal Sponsorship is a partnership in which a 501(c)3 nonprofit (“the fiscal sponsor”) sponsors a project so the project can access grants and tax-deductible contributions.

We fiscally sponsor artists and art groups who aren't ready (or don't want) to become a nonprofit organization. With fiscal sponsorship, you're held under our tax-exempt status without the bureaucratic burdens of running a nonprofit. We provide fund management, send your thank-you letters, track your expenses and much more.

\*We don't award grants or apply for grants on behalf of our fiscally sponsored projects. Instead, we make you eligible for grants.
